

Job Title: Teacher of Economics

We are looking to recruit a member of staff on a permanent basis. We will consider either part time or full time working.

The department

Economics is part of the Faculty of Social Science. The area is well resourced; A level teaching takes place in the modern Carville building where the spacious classrooms are equipped with interactive and audio-visual equipment. College-wide issues, including pastoral provision, as well as some general subject issues are dealt with at the faculty level. However, detailed subject development occurs within subject departments. Resources and ideas for teaching Economics lessons are shared within the department. In addition to teaching their subjects, members of staff may have other responsibilities including personal tutoring, admissions interviews and recreational activities.

The Economics department consists of seven teachers delivering the Edexcel Economics course to A-level. This year over 550 students studied Economics, many of whom are very able and highly motivated. The course is well-established and has maintained very good results in recent years. The exam results for the department in 2023 were as follows:
