RESPONSIBILITIES:

- h) To upload learning materials and additional study resources to our VLE which at least meet the minimum standard.
- i) To devise assessments which are at an appropriate standard, and assess the learners against the aims and objectives of the programme and, where necessary, meet awarding body requirements as appropriate
- j) To include a regular schedule of setting, marking and returning work to learners within agreed deadlines as appropriate
- k) Track and record individual learner's progress and achievements as appropriate
- I) To carry out scholarly activity and maintain professional currency as appropriate
- m) To ensure all necessary administration connected with the course is completed including registers and risk assessments
- n) Read the Health & Safety Policy in the Staff File and observe the regulations paying particular regard to the health and safety of all learners
